

## Attrition Attribute Analysis, Fall 2017 Cohort

The purpose of this report was to identify the student attributes from the Fall 2017 cohort of new students that did not return for the Fall 2018 semester.

### Results

In Fall 2017, there were 3,422 new students. Table 1 depicts a breakdown of the one-year attrition rates for various categories of students. The groups that had the highest attrition rates included part-time students and transfer freshmen students.

Limited data were available to determine the reasons why students departed. Of the 883 students that departed, only 146 students had withdrawal reasons documented. The most common withdrawal reason code was *voluntary withdrawal* for first-time freshmen (56) and transfer (65) students. Other withdrawal reasons included: *transferring out* (9), *medical/health* (6), *financial* (3), and *self-withdrawal due to difficulty with studies* (7). 24 students that had a withdrawal reason also had an *academic alert* status for their academic standing. Four students has a *Dean's List* status for their academic standing; one departed for medical reasons and 3 were voluntary withdrawals.

**FTFT Freshmen.** Tables 2-5 depict the one-year and fall-spring attrition rates for first-time full-time freshmen by various categories of students.
