Required materials: Writing sample. Please submit a 5–10 page paper (double-spaced), preferably one written for a history class within the last five years. The paper should demonstrate your ability to analyze primary and secondary sources.
Supplemental writing prompt: Optional
Personal statement: Your statement of purpose is an opportunity to show the graduate admissions committee why you want to pursue a graduate degree and what your specific goals and interests are.
