UMass Boston, with 15,575 enrolled undergraduate and graduate students in fall 2024, is nationally recognized as a model of excellence for urban public universities. The university's 6 colleges and schools offer 69 undergraduate programs and 150 graduate programs (including master's and doctoral programs). The Honors College serves 439 students who thrive on intellectual challenge. Enriched courses probe more deeply into theory or venture further into application.



### Age of UMass Boston Undergraduates in 2024


