



OLLI at UMass Boston: Integrated Sciences Complex (ISC) Campus Map & Directions



- **Red Circle – West Garage.** This is the closest on-campus parking garage to the ISC. The OLLI office will provide a free parking pass for those driving to campus for the summer open house. Please keep the ticket you take when entering the garage; you'll need that to exit the garage when you leave.
- **Light Blue Circle – Integrated Sciences Complex.** Spotlight on OLLI is taking place on the first floor, in the building's atrium.
- **Campus Shuttle Stop.** The main shuttle (Route 1 from the JFK/UMass T station as well as the Bayside parking lot) stops outside the front of the ISC. The stop is located at the rotary and is represented by a pinkish dot on the campus map circled in light blue.
Please see additional details about the campus shuttle at the end of this document.
- There is also a small drop-off/pick-up lot outside the ISC. Can be used for Uber/Lyft or if a family/friend is providing transportation for you.

The official address of UMass Boston is 100 Morrissey Boulevard. The campus shares Columbia Point with the JFK Library, Edward M. Kennedy Institute, and the State Archives.



WEST GARAGE

The West Garage is located on University Drive West. **If you are entering the campus from Morrissey Blvd**, you will want to take the second exit once you enter the rotary. After exiting the rotary, the West Garage will be on your left. Continue to the first set of lights, and turn left to enter the parking garage.

If you are coming to campus on Mt. Vernon Street, you will want to turn right at the set of lights by the Keith Motley Residence Hall Complex. There is a large UMass Boston sign in front of the residence halls at this stop light intersection. After turning right onto University Drive West, you will proceed to the first set of lights and turn right in order to enter the West Garage.

Finding the Integrated Sciences Building (ISC) *(from the West Garage)*



After parking in the West Garage you should exit the parking garage and walk across the street to the ISC building. Technically from this picture's view point, you are looking at the "back" of the ISC building with the four rows of windows.

Getting into the ISC is rather easy from the West Garage. After your cross the street, continue walking between the Quinn and the ISC up the sidewalk (the ISC will be on your right). You will slightly walk under the pedestrian bridge that connects the two buildings, and the entrance to the ISC main/1st Floor will then be off to your right. See pictures below:



Alternative Routes

- **From the West Garage.** After your cross the street from the West Garage, you can also follow the sidewalk and go around to the front of the building and enter the main front doors. The "front" of the building is the all-glass side that faces the rotary and water.

If you plan to stay for the Boston Harbor boat cruise after the open house, the Fox Point boat dock (circled in bright pink) is about a 5-7 minute walk from the ISC building.

Additional free campus shuttle (bus) information. During the summer, the shuttles are a bit less frequent as there are fewer students and events on campus...about every 10-15 minutes. The shuttles are operated by Paul Revere and typically are either a white bus with "Paul Revere" on the side or it is a "wrapped/painted" bus with the UMass Boston colors and logo. Please note there is a shuttle for the Longwood Medical Area that takes employees to Longwood. It is also a blue bus and you will not want to get on that as it will take you in the opposite direction. **You can always ask the bus driver to make sure you are on the right shuttle.**

The boarding area for the UMass Boston campus shuttle is located by a black information booth (which is not in use). After going through the fare gates for the Red Line, turn right and proceed down the stairs or ramp. You see the black wooden booth along side an enclosed bus waiting shelter.
